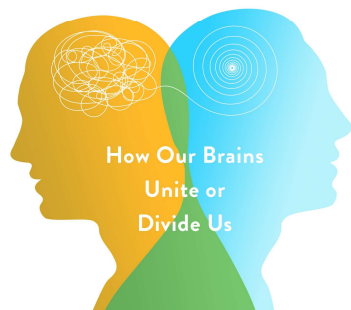

The Immanuel process

- ▶ Immanuel
- ▶ Mutual mind – sharing thoughts
- ▶ Hebrew concept: Thought rhyming (Psalm 78:15-16)
 - ▶ *He split the rocks in the wilderness and gave them water as abundant as the seas; he brought streams out of a rocky crag and made water flow down like rivers.*
